<b>Educational goals and characteristics</b>	<p>The fellow will be part of an established Limb Reconstruction Service, comprising of two surgeons, a specialist nurse and a specialist physiotherapist. Training will be provided in the following ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Analysis of deformity - clinical, radiological and gait laboratory</li> <li>• Clinicopathological tutorials and journal review</li> <li>• Preoperative planning sessions</li> <li>• Operative surgical experience as assistant and supervised surgeon according to expertise (please note that this is subject to qualification recognition by the Medical Practitioners Board of Victoria)</li> <li>• Postoperative review with physiotherapist, clinical nurse specialist and supervising surgeon</li> <li>• Workshops for the study of cross-sectional anatomy and application of external fixation</li> <li>• Exposure to ancillary surgery related to limb reconstruction.</li> </ul>	
<b>Requirements/criteria</b>	Registrar (or equivalent) who has completed or is near to completion of their specialist training in orthopaedics
