Educational goals and characteristics	<p>The 6-12 month fellowship is based publicly at Western Health (Footscray, Sunshine and Williamstown Hospitals) and privately at St Vincent's private hospital East Melbourne / Werribee and Bellbird Private Hospital.</p> <p>Western Health is one of the largest tertiary adult teaching hospitals in Melbourne with over 3000 elective and trauma cases performed each year. The unit has 21 orthopaedic surgeons and 9 registrars.</p> <p>The Fellowship is based in private and public hospitals with a focus on anterior approach hip replacements and hip arthroscopy. There is also exposure to kinematically aligned knee replacements using the subvastus approach, robotic assisted partial knee replacements, shoulder arthroscopy and arthroplasty. The department actively collects prospective outcome data on patients and fellows would be able to generate clinical outcome research.</p> <p>Opportunity exists to further fellowship experience in shoulder, hip, knee and foot / ankle surgery through the other departmental orthopaedic surgeons.</p> <p>Duties include, but are not limited to, assisting in the private surgical setting, participating in orthopaedic clinics at Footscray Hospital and participating in all the Unit clinical and academic meetings. There is also opportunity for independent</p>	

	<p>operating for suitable candidates in the public hospital for elective and trauma cases in both adult and paediatrics.</p> <p>Learning objectives for the fellowship are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To learn and perform the direct anterior approach to the hip. 2. To learn and perform hip arthroscopy including impingement surgery and labral repairs 3. To undertake research - the Fellow is expected to prepare minimum 1 paper for publication within 6 months and present one of these at a national or international meeting.
<p>Requirements/ criteria</p>	<p>All candidates must be eligible for registration by the Australian Medical Practitioners' Board. Applicants must be a fully qualified orthopaedic surgeon with an Orthopaedic postgraduate fellowship (FRACS) or equivalent.</p>
