Educational goals and characteristics	This fellowship is based at Royal Brisbane Hospital, Queensland's largest hospital and one of two tertiary referral centres in Brisbane for trauma. The fellowship offers exposure to all aspects of upper limb trauma including microsurgery as well as elective upper limb cases (shoulder to hand). There will also be exposure to local / regional flaps as well as peripheral nerve/ brachial plexus surgery. There is no formal oncall requirement, but fellows are encouraged to attend replants and complex cases. There is a close association with Lady Cilento Children's Hospital; the fellow has the opportunity to attend clinics / operating lists at LCCH where there will be exposure to paediatric upper limb cases ranging from brachial plexus to congenital hand surgery.
