Educational goals and characteristics	This exciting opportunity is based at the new Royal Adelaide Hospital which is a major trauma hospital accepting referrals from all of South Australia and interstate. As the Pelvic Fellow the goal of the fellowship is to gain experience in Pelvic fractures and complex trauma under the direct supervision of experienced sub-specialised Orthopaedic surgeons. Approximately 100 pelvic and acetabular fractures are fixed per year and the pelvic fellow will be able to be involved in all cases. There will be an opportunity to perform more routine fractures as part of the general on-call commitments. The role includes teaching of the more junior Orthopaedic registrars and medical students. On call requirements include being second on call for a junior registrar on average once per week and 1:4 weekend days. The fellow will also hold an honorary position at the University of Adelaide as a Clinical Lecturer and will be expected to be involved in many research projects including clinical, cadaver and basic science.
