Educational Goals:

Fellows will obtain an all-encompassing world-class experience in the diagnosis and surgical management of a wide range of knee conditions. This includes exposure to sports related conditions, ACL reconstruction, other ligament reconstructive procedures, joint preservation procedures including osteotomy and robotic assisted total knee replacement. The Centaur Institute also offers exposure to cutting-edge research activities conducted within its Human Performance Laboratory. Fellows will be expected to produce at least one paper suitable for publication in a peer reviewed journal.

Educational Qualifications/Requirements:

Fellowship applications must include: • A cover letter including a photograph, professional goals, and career plans on completion of fellowship. • FRACS or equivalent international qualifications. • Certified copies of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees. • Current CV. • Two written references from senior orthopaedic surgeons with whom you have worked with in the last 2 years. • All candidates must be competent in speaking, writing, and understanding the English language. International applicants will need to provide IELTS results as proof of English proficiency, with a score of at least 7 in every unit in one sitting.
