Educational Goals:

This fellowship is designed to provide exposure to complex cases within a focused breadth of knee surgery for surgeons seeking to refine their expertise within a high-volume, specialist private practice environment.

The fellow will be embedded within a modern, streamlined practice performing approximately 500 surgical cases annually, encompassing a balanced and sophisticated case mix.

This includes high-volume anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction, primary knee arthroplasty (including robotic-assisted techniques), and arthroscopic knee surgery, alongside exposure to complex primary, revision, and realignment procedures. The integration of MAKO robotic technology in knee arthroplasty provides the fellow with valuable experience in contemporary alignment strategies, preoperative planning, and precision execution.

Educational Qualifications/Requirements:

This position is best suited to a highly motivated surgeon who has completed orthopaedic training and is seeking a focused, high-yield fellowship to consolidate their skills in knee surgery at an advanced level.

The fellowship includes dedicated research time and the successful applicant will be expected to prepare at least one project to the level of final draft during the tenure of the fellowship.

Adequate provision for free time has been allocated in the timetable, such that the fellow will not work more than 32 hours per week. The timetable carries some flexibility to ensure this occurs.

The applicant must:

- Be eligible for registration with the Medical Board of Australia (AHPRA)
- Have the appropriate level of postgraduate orthopaedic training
- Have evidence of research experience, including relevant published research
- Must meet AHPRA English proficiency Requirements
- International applicants must have a valid IELTS academic certificate with a minimum score of 7 for each competency
- International applicants must satisfy requirements to enter Australia on an occupational training visa.
