Educational goals and characteristics	Royal North Shore Hospital is a 600-bed quaternary referral hospital. It offers an established and comprehensive Spine Fellowship Program under the supervision of four specialist Spine Surgeons. Exposure is offered to the full spectrum of Adult Sp. Surgery, including trauma, tumour, infection, deformity and degenerative disease. Fellows participate in over 400 surgeries per annum. Duties include participation in surgery, participation in outpatient clinics and management of emergency presentations. Royal North Shore Hospital is a state-wreferral centre for spinal cord injury. All adult spine pathologies are managed and the fellowship offers ample exposure to the management of complex spine deformity. Training is provided in navigation technologies.				
	Clinical support is provided by a full complement of training registrars and residents within a teaching hospital environment. Fellows are required to complete a research project – clinical and basic science options are available through our affiliation with The University of Sydney. Fellows are employees of New South Wales Health and appointed via a competitive annual recruitment process.
