<b>Educational goals and characteristics</b>	<p>The aim of the Brisbane Foot and Ankle Fellowship is to provide subspecialty training in foot and ankle surgery. The fellowship will provide extensive exposure to general and complex foot and ankle surgery under the supervision of 3 subspecialty Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle surgeons working both publicly and privately.</p> <p>All 3 supervisors have a keen interest in MIS or arthroscopic surgery as well as in the development and specialization of total ankle replacement surgery using the latest 3D printing technology and patient pre-operative planning.</p> <p>It is hoped that by completion the Fellow will have had adequate and thorough exposure to all conservative/surgical options to manage foot &amp; ankle conditions in both adults and children.</p> <p>The Fellowship entails both work in the public and private sector, with the Fellow being allowed access to set Trauma lists at the public hospital under guidance of one of the supervisors. The Fellow will also be required to attend the High Risk Foot Clinic publicly allowing exposure to neuropathic/Charcot/diabetic foot &amp; ankle conditions, including the opportunity to assist privately with all 3 of the supervisors. The fellowship offers significant exposure to MIS hindfoot/forefoot/bunion surgery, arthritic fusions including arthroscopic ankle/subtalar/triple arthrodesis etc, arthritic total Ankle Replacements /revision Total Ankle Replacements, complex deformity correction, exposure to multidisciplinary diabetic foot management in a tertiary referral centre, various foot and ankle trauma and all other non-surgical in house Physio/Podiatry input to optimize treatment to all things foot &amp; ankle.</p> <p>There will also be a requirement to contribute towards research, with appropriate time during each week allocated towards data collection or research engagement.</p>	

<b>Requirements/ criteria</b>	Applicants must have either completed their orthopaedic training (FRACS or equivalent, MS / DNB, American Board or equivalent) or must be in the final year of their training. All candidates must have completed the IELTS Academic English language test (or equivalent) with a minimum score of 7 in every section (www.ielts.org). This is a strict criterion for registration with the Medical Board of Australia. Graduates from universities in the USA, Canada, UK, NZ and Australia are exempt.
