Educational goals and characteristics	<p>The Mudgeeraba Hand Clinic Hand Fellowship offers comprehensive training in both elective and trauma-related hand and wrist surgery. Fellows gain experience under the guidance of orthopaedic and plastic surgeons working collaboratively within a single, integrated unit.</p> <p>The fellowship provides exposure to a broad spectrum of procedures, including arthroscopy, Microsurgery (including free tissue transfer, replantation/revascularisation, nerve transfers) arthroplasty, congenital hand surgery and trauma. Fellows will assist consultant surgeons in theatre, attend dedicated fellow and consultant clinics, and manage the follow-up of their surgical cases. Clinical work is supported by a multidisciplinary team of seven hand therapists, with backgrounds in both physiotherapy and occupational therapy, ensuring a holistic approach to patient care. The fellowship offers significant research opportunities in association with ARCH (Australian research collaboration on hands).</p>	
Requirements/ criteria	<p>Medical registration with AHPRA MBBS or MD degree Professional indemnity insurance covering surgical assisting, consulting under supervision and primary surgeon (if applicable) FRACS (or equivalent) in Orthopaedic or Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Please note that the Medical Board of Australia requires all international medical graduates to provide proof of English language proficiency before registration. International applicants from countries in which English is the second language must provide results of English language test with a minimum band of 7 in each component of the test. A successful result needs to be forwarded prior to the interview.</p>
