Educational goals and characteristics	The aim of this fellowship is to provide extensive clinical experience in both the nonoperative and operative management of elective shoulder disorders Chief Supervisor, A/Prof Mark Haber has a keen interest in shoulder ultrasound as a diagnostic tool and the fellow will have ample opportunity to develop a skill in performing his own studies. This fellowship also includes an emphasis on both clinical research and biomechanical studies surrounding elective shoulder surgical issues. The Fellow therefore focuses mainly on: • Clinical assessment • Diagnostic ultrasound for shoulder conditions • Shoulder arthroplasty and arthroscopy with some exposure on other sports reconstructive surgery. Research plays a vital role in the fellowship programme. The fellow will be given a number of research projects suitable for presentation at an international meeting and publication in a peer-reviewed journal. It is the responsibility of the fellow to assist the supervisors to prepare and submit abstracts and publications.	

Requirements/ criteria	Medical Degree and specialist qualification as an orthopaedic surgeon recognisable by AHPRA (Australian, Health Practitioner Regulation Agency) for appropriate registration in an educational fellowship. As this is a clinical fellowship, good interpersonal skills and evidence of English language proficiency is mandatory. Medical registration is dependent on an academic IELTS pass of 7 or above in all four components.
