Educational goals and characteristics	This is a comprehensive, all-encompassing Foot and Ankle Fellowship that will prepare the Fellow for full-time practice in foot and ankle orthopaedic surgery. Fellows will be exposed to the practices of four fellowship-trained foot and ankle surgeons who have all completed fellowships in the USA. Their exposure will include but not be limited to sports medicine, arthroscopy, deformity correction, reconstruction, trauma, and paediatric foot and ankle care. There is a particular focus on utilisation of the latest, evidence-based treatments with a particular emphasis on modern techniques in total ankle replacement surgery, minimally invasive surgery, and deformity correction. There are ample opportunities on public lists for fellows to obtain operative experience. They will also gain ample education opportunities through assisting in clinics and private operating lists. The Fellow is expected to be involved in at least one research project throughout their time with the unit, and there are a number of ongoing projects that the Fellow can assist with.	
Requirements/ criteria	All candidates should have completed the orthopaedic training in their country of origin and be eligible for registration with the New South Wales Medical Board, Australia. All candidates should be fluent in English, with a pass of at least 7 in all modules of the IELTS English Language Test, or have evidence of secondary schooling in a country where English is the native language. An Occupational Training Visa for Australia is required (arranged after confirmation of appointment).	
How to Apply	Applications with curriculum vitae, three recent referees and a short paragraph on what the fellow hopes to achieve from the fellowship should be sent to Dr Jeff Ling. Applications are accepted 24 months in advance.
