Educational goals and characteristics	The Fellowship provides broad based training in Paediatric Orthopaedics with a focus on trauma, hip, neuromuscular conditions, deformity correction and limb lengthening, knee and sports surgery and foot and ankle surgery. Congenital hand and upper limb clinics can also be attended. Separate Fellowships is available for Paediatric/Adult Spine Deformity and Paediatric/Adult Knee. The Orthopaedic Department has 5 teaching sessions per week for Fellows and Registrars as well as interactive teaching in the elective outpatient clinics. Fellows participate in an on call roster on a 1 in 5 basis. Clinical responsibilities include operative and outpatient work.		
	One of two 12-month fellowships in Paediatric Orthopaedics available at The Children's Hospital at Westmead commencing in February and August each year Junior medical staff include 4 accredited registrars, 1 unaccredited Registrar, Spine and Knee Fellows. The Fellowship provides leadership opportunities in teamwork and organisation.
