Educational goals and characteristics	The purpose of the Sydney Children's Hospital Orthopaedic Fellowship is to provide specialist training in Paediatric Orthopaedic Surgery to orthopaedic surgeons wishing to sub-specialise. Depending on the level of experience on entry to the Fellowship program, it is anticipated that the Paediatric Orthopaedic Fellow (on completion of 12 months training) would be proficient in the acute surgical management of paediatric trauma, paediatric hip conditions, foot and ankle, cerebral palsy, reconstruction, paediatric upper limb and paediatric sport knee conditions. There will be some exposure to paediatric spine during the 12 months of fellowship.
