	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Independently manage general trauma and orthopaedic cases.</li> <li>• Participate in afterhours cover Senior Registrar/Fellow level.</li> <li>• Participate in clinical audit of care, including morbidity and mortality reporting</li> <li>• Demonstrated commitment to teaching.</li> <li>• Demonstrated capability and interest in research.</li> <li>• Demonstrated ability to communicate at all levels.</li> <li>• Demonstrated teamwork and collaboration.</li> </ul>
