Educational goals and characteristics	This exciting opportunity is based at the new Royal Adelaide Hospital which is a major trauma hospital accepting referrals from all of South Australia and interstate. The goal of the fellowship is to gain experience in the management of complex trauma peri-articular fractures of both the upper and lower extremities and complex limb reconstruction cases where Masquelet techniques or Ilizarov methods are required. There will be an opportunity to perform more routine fractures as part of the general on-call commitments. The role includes teaching of the junior Orthopaedic registrars and medical students. On call requirements include being second on call for a junior registrar on average once per week and 1:4 weekend days. Upon completion of the fellowship, the fellow should have an experience that would allow them to function independently with confidence as a consultant in another dedicated Trauma Unit. The fellow will also hold An honorary position as a Clinical Lecturer at the University of Adelaide with an expectation of being involved in many research projects including clinical, cadaver and basic science.
