The Fellow will also have exposure in the assessment and treatment of injuries and trauma that present to fracture clinic.</p> <p>An opportunity for direct involvement in our Multi-Disciplinary Complex Limb Reconstruction Clinic utilising the collaboration of multiple specialists in order to provide innovative and complex surgical options.</p> <p>The fellow will have direct exposure and involvement in the preoperative planning, design and utilisation of 3D printed patient specific instruments to allow precision and accuracy in complex limb deformity correction and reconstruction.</p> <p>This experience will take place in a supervised environment to optimise the potential for learning and is associated with preparation of clinical research for presentation and publication.</p>
